Dear Resident/Occupier,

Advance warning of works in the Beddington Lane area (14th & 15th August)

At their meeting on 20th October 2015, the Beddington and Wallington Local Committee, Councillors approved a proposal for a 20 MPH speed limit for Beddington Village (from the A232 Croydon Road through to Harrington Close).

An Informal Consultation into the proposal ran for just over three weeks during March 2016 and this was used to shape the subsequent Statutory Consultation, which ran from May into June 2016.

The Statutory Consultation resulted in no objections to the proposal and the Council now wishes to implement the proposal fully.

To do this on the evening of the 14th and 15th August 2017, the Council will be implementing roadmarkings in Beddington Lane. The roadmarkings will mostly comprise of "edge of carriageway" lines and 20 MPH roundels and "slow" markings being put in at regular intervals.


The Contractor will be using Temporary Traffic Signals (to protect their workforce) and will be working from 22:00pm through until 05:00am at the latest. We would not expect there to be a lot of noise but there will be some disruption and inconvenience.

The Contractor feels that the works can be carried out during the 14th & 15th August, but where the process is subject to the weather (the linemarking material cannot be laid in wet conditions) we may need to have the 16th August as a fallback date.

At the same time as this, signs will be installed near the exit from the A232 Croydon Road into Beddington Lane and near Harrington Close. This will then make the edges of the 20 MPH Limit and from here the Council will then do the adjacent side roads over the following week(s). The Contractor has estimated that signing and lining the adjacent roads will take 1-2 weeks and this work will be carried out during the day (as the side roads are quieter).
